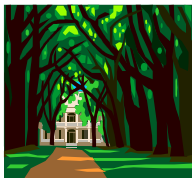
2. This Rough Rider President was equal to just about anything. For a while after his first wife died, he lived in the Badlands of South Dakota. Who was he?
